

RESOLUTION NO. 3590

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING CITY OF NEWPORT WORKERS' COMPENSATION COVERAGE TO VOLUNTEERS OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT FOR COVERAGE YEAR 2012/2013

Findings:

Pursuant to ORS 656.031, workers' compensation coverage will be provided to the classes of volunteer workers listed in this resolution and noted on CIS payroll schedule:

1. An assumed monthly wage of \$1,800 will be used for public safety volunteers (volunteer firefighters and police reserve officers); and an assumed hourly wage of \$8.80 will be used for library, parks and recreation, airport, and police volunteers; and
2. An aggregate assumed annual wage of \$2,500 will be used per volunteer board, commission, and/or council for the performance of administrative duties; and
3. An assumed monthly wage of \$800 per month will be used for public officials for the performance of manual labor above and beyond the administrative duties described in paragraph 2 above; and
4. Non-public safety volunteers will keep track of their hours and have their assumed payroll reported in the correct class code for the type of work being performed using Oregon minimum wage; and
5. Court-mandated community service workers/inmates on work release who are sentenced by the Lincoln County Circuit Court will keep track of their hours and have their assumed payroll reported in Class Code 7720V using Oregon minimum wage; and
6. A roster of active volunteers will be kept monthly for reporting purposes. It is acknowledged that CIS may request copies of these rosters during year-end audit; and
7. Unanticipated volunteer projects or exposure not addressed herein will be added onto the City of Newport's coverage agreement (1) by endorsement;

Based on these Findings, The City of Newport resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City of Newport will provide for workers' compensation insurance coverage as indicated above.

Section 2. This resolution will be updated annuals.

Section 3. This resolution will become effective on July 1, 2012.


