Suspect: Joshua Steven Mayes, age 25 of Newport

Details: On 10/22/2010 at about 1:58 a.m., Newport Police Officers responded to a report of a fight in progress at Moby Dick's Lounge on Hwy 101 in Newport. Before officers arrived, two of the suspects involved fled the scene. One of these suspects was observed by several witnesses to break out a large window of the nearby Red Lotus Music store with his fist, and then continue to flee. Officers followed a blood trail and later located the suspect at Samaritan Pacific Communities Hospital.

The suspect was identified as Joshua Steven Mayes of Newport. Mayes was reported to be intoxicated, and was uncooperative with officers who attempted to interview him. Mayes attempted to assault one of the officers, two of whom deployed their Tasers on Mayes in order to bring him under control.

After receiving medical care in the emergency room of the hospital, Mayes was transported to the Lincoln County Jail. Mayes was lodged on two charges of Disorderly Conduct II, Criminal Mischief II, and Resisting Arrest. His bail was set at \$60,000.
