Details: On 01/24/2013, Newport Police Officers received a request for assistance from Lincoln County Parole and Probation to help locate a convicted sex offender. Jose Frede Rodriguez-Aguilar, (aka Freddy) age 24 of Newport, had absconded from supervision; he was wanted on a felony Parole Violation warrant. Several persons in the Newport area were contacted and arrested while searching for Rodriguez-Aguilar.

At the first location, Ronald "Ronnie" Evert Larson, age 20 of Newport, was arrested on an outstanding felony Probation Violation warrant, and on a misdemeanor warrant for Failure to Appear. He was lodged at the Lincoln County Jail with bail set at \$100,000.

At the same location, Tori Lynn Williams, age 20 of Newport, was arrested on a Probation Violation detainer. She was in possession of suspected methamphetamine. She was lodged at the Lincoln County Jail on the felony Probation Violation detainer, and new charges of Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance. Due to the detainer, no bail was set at this time. A suspected stolen firearm was also seized at this location.

At a second location, Rodriguez-Aguilar was found hiding in a closet. He was taken into custody on the felony Parole Violation warrant and lodged at the Lincoln County Jail, where a new charge of Failure to Register as a Sex Offender was attached. Due to the Parole Violation warrant, no bail was set at this time.

At the second location, three persons were arrested for Hindering Prosecution by helping hide Rodriguez-Aguilar in the closet. Arrested were Adam Francis Anderson, age 29 of Newport, James Michael Mistele, age 22 of Newport, and Sara R. McClaugherty, age 30 of Newport. When arrested, Mistele was in possession of suspected methamphetamine. All three were lodged in the Lincoln County Jail. Anderson and McClaugherty bail was set at \$50,000 each; Mistele's bail was set at \$100,000.
