Details: On 08/21/2012 at 2:00 p.m., Newport Police Officers responded to report of theft at Wal-Mart. Two subjects had taken items out of the store, and then brought them back inside in an attempt to return the items for store credit.

Wal-Mart security staff spotted the pair, and attempted to stop them before they exited the store. Both subjects ran out of the store, pursued by security staff who also phoned the Newport Police. When police officers arrived, the security crew indicated the direction the two suspects were last seen traveling. Officers quickly located the suspects who were still in possession of the items they had taken from the store. They were identified as Keith Raymond Tull, age 34 of Eugene, and Sarah Elise Nightingale, age 30 of Depoe Bay. Nightingale, who had jumped over a steep ravine in an attempt to elude officers, was removed with the help of a rope rescue team. She complained of a possible broken ankle, and was taken to Samaritan Pacific Communities Hospital. She was treated, taken into custody, and transported to the Lincoln County Jail. The suspects were charged with Theft II, and Attempt Theft I. Their bail was set at \$30,000 each.
