## Project Status December 2015

Site work is progressing speedily on the Aquatic Center. All of the pipe work is completed crossing SE 10<sup>th</sup> Street and the street is scheduled to be paved December 21<sup>st</sup>. We are not expecting to have to close the street again after that work.

The contractor will be stubbing utilities north on Avery Street between the 60+ Center and the Recreation Center to SE  $2^{nd}$  Street. There will be a one lane closure with a flagger at the intersection of SE  $2^{nd}$  and Avery beginning December  $16^{th}$  while the utility work is underway.

The contractor has begun the excavation for the foundation of the Aquatic Center building. Over the next several weeks they will be hauling material from the site so please beware of the additional truck traffic.

Beginning the week of December 21<sup>st</sup>, the contractor will demolish the curb and sidewalk on the west side of Avery Street between the 60+ Center and the Recreation Center. A walking path will be designated from the parking lot to the south to provide safe access to the 60+ Center and the Recreation Center. Please watch for the pedestrian signs that provide direction regarding where it is safe to walk.
