

CITY OF NEWPORT CONTRACTUAL SCOPE OF WORK TASK 4 - BIG CREEK DAMS TRAVEL

May 13, 2020

1. BACKGROUND

The City of Newport (City) has chosen Dig Deep Research, LLC (Dig Deep) to provide professional strategic planning services in FY2021 to advance its ongoing fundraising efforts for the Big Creek Dam Replacement Project. The following Contractual Scope of Work describes the activities, schedule and cost estimates for travel related to the BCD fundraising in FY2021.

2. APPROACH

Advance state and federal government relations efforts to engage and inform legislative officials to advocate for legislative funding specifically for Big Creek Dams as well as establish new government funding sources for dam remediation.

Activities related to Big Creek Dam Travel:

- Schedule and attend meetings with key federal agency officials, members of Congress, and congressional committee staff in Washington, DC.
- Coordinate and liaise with federal and state lobbying subconsultants, legislative officials and other stakeholders including heads of relevant government agencies, special interest groups.
- Complete travel planning, and participate in out-of-town travel activities (i.e., flight, ground transportation, etc).

4.1 Cost

The total cost estimate for BCD-related travel for fiscal year ending 2021 (7/1/2020 to 6/30/2021) is \$57,188. This cost estimate includes all travel-related activities required to conduct the work described in Task 2 and Task 3 Work orders. Costs will be submitted for reimbursement as expenses are incurred. Due to the national Covid Pandemic, it is possible expenses will be much less if travel is prohibited.

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
