## **APPLICATION SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS**

## Sign Variance (greater than 40% of a numerical standard) (Planning Commission Type III decision-making process)

The following must be submitted with a City of Newport Land Use application for a sign variance processed as a Type III decision:

- □1. A site plan prepared by a registered surveyor or licensed professional civil engineer and drawn to scale with appropriate survey monuments shown, showing the dimensions and arrangement of the proposed sign on the applicant's lot.
- □2. For requests to deviate from sign height limitations, architectural elevations drawn to scale illustrating the proposed sign.
- **3**. An illustration of the proposed signage.
- □4. An inventory of all signs including the location, type and size of each sign on the property.
- □5. A current 18" x 24" Lincoln County Assessor's tax map(s) showing the subject property and the notification area. The notification area is all properties within 200 feet of the subject property. (Lincoln County Assessor's office is located in the Lincoln County Courthouse at 225 W Olive St, Newport)
- □6. A list of names and addresses of property owners, as shown in the records of the Lincoln County Assessor, within the notification area described in #4 above.
- **7**. Written findings of fact addressing the following criteria:
  - □ That the variance is consistent with the purposes of the sign code, as provided in Newport Municipal Code §10.10.010 and §10.15.005; and
  - □ That the variance will allow for placement of a sign with exceptional design, style, or circumstance, or will allow a sign that is more consistent with the architecture and development of the site; and
  - That the variance will not significantly increase or led to street level sign clutter, nor will it create a traffic or safety hazard.
- □8. A written explanation of the specific request (e.g. a height adjustment) and the percentage of variance requested.
- **9**. Fee of \$653.00.
